



COMMUNITY LIFESTYLE STATEMENT

I want to demonstrate Jesus love towards others at TeenStreet and to please God by the way I behave. For that reason I agree to follow the CLS...

- [a] I will show love and respect for all people at TeenStreet regardless of their nationality, Church background, language or culture.
- [b] Illegal actions are, of course, forbidden at TeenStreet. I understand that by law the leaders are required to report crimes to the police. including drug taking or possession of drugs, the use of knives, violent behaviour, threats, vandalism, racism, etc.
- [c] During TeenStreet I will not drink alcohol on or off site.
- [d] At TeenStreet I will not smoke or use tobacco in any other way on or off site. (Note: it is illegal for teens under the age of 16 to use tobacco in Germany)
- [e] I will follow the instructions of staff and leaders. If there is a reason not to do so, I will first talk with my M&M leader or HO representative. If I am not a teen participant, I will talk with the supervisor or another senior leader.
- [f] I will not swear or use other offensive language at TeenStreet.
- [g] I understand that all teens and coaches must take part in the daily programme and must talk with an M&M leader if an exception needs to be made (health, need of sleep etc)
- [h] I understand that teens can only leave the site during the afternoon and must stay together in groups of three or more people. I understand that teens must inform their coach before leaving the site.
- [i] I will always carry my ID (wristband and nametag) visibly, both on the site and when approaching the entrances.
- [j] I understand that all teens and coaches must be at the accommodation at 23.16. All must be quiet and lights off at 23.56. Guys cannot enter girl's accommodation areas and girls cannot enter guy's accommodation areas.
- [k] I understand that there should be no alarm clocks or mobile phone alarms before 06.36 so that other people can sleep and that the latest up time is at 07.56.
- [l] I will not borrow, move or touch anyone's belongings without their permission.
- [m] I will not stand on chairs because this is forbidden on the site.
- [n] I understand that inline skates, skateboards, etc are only allowed in designated areas and that ball games, Frisbees and similar games are only allowed outside the buildings
- [o] I am committed to follow the TS Dress-code for this week (see overleaf).



THE DRESS CODE

- [1]** Please cover too much rather than too little. We may need to come to you and ask you to put more on or to change something. Do not take that personally. We just want to help you so what you are wearing will not offend others. If you are unsure please ask your coach.
- [2]** Only wear swimwear at the swimming pool. Wear modest swimwear that is not see-through and that covers the private parts of the body well.
- [3]** Everyone should wear tops – no see-through or very low cut tops. Guys must wear their shirts even when playing sports.
- [4]** Do not wear clothes or accessories bearing offensive text or graphics (for example messages about drugs, violence, fascism, sex or the occult)
- [5]** Girls should wear bras or an equivalent
- [6]** Tops and trousers / skirts should meet
- [7]** Shorts must be at least mid thigh length.
- [8]** Skirts must be at least to just above the knee length

I agree with the TeenStreet Community Lifestyle Statement. I will live this way during the TeenStreet event. I understand that there will be consequences for breaking these rules, based on the seriousness of the offence. This may include informing my parent or guardian and being removed from active TeenStreet participation. (If the consequences include going home or have to be taken off site, that will be at the expenses of the parents or family of the teenager).
